JOIN THE LARGEST GATHERING OF PIPER CUBS IN EUROPE EVER!!!

This year marks the 75'th anniversary of the famous Piper Cub, and is as a very appropriate theme for the 2010 South Swedish Vintage Fly-In. At the closure of WW2, Swedish entrepreneur aviator Albin Ahrenberg imported 90 surplus US Army Cubs. They became an affordable path giving wings to thousands of Scandinavian flying enthusiasts lasting more than half a century.

Join Cub owners and pilots from all over Europe for a great weekend and a memorable celebration of this fantastic aircraft and its ancestors!

Eslöv Airfield, ESME, was established 1934 as a reserve landing site for the Airmail Line Stockholm - Hamburg. It was later a training field for hundreds of military pilots during the war years, and following the war, was the base for five large crop dusting companies. Today, ESME is the home of 40 aircraft and the vintage aviation center of South Sweden.
